**Proposition 3**

The Constitution Review Committee hereby recommends the following proposition. The major difference between Proposition 2 and 3:

Proposition 2 states that the number of Board of Directors will remain 7, BAH will appoint a number of zonal directors based on population, BAC will be managed by a Committee and the BAC director will be appointed by the BAH Board of Directors

Proposition 3 states that the number of Board of Directors will be increased to 9, two new Directors will be elected (BAC Director and PR Director), BAH will appoint a number of zonal directors based on population, BAC will be managed by a BoD appointed committee members.

**Highlight of the proposed amendments:**

**Article-V Management of the Association**

**Section 1. Board of Directors: The activities of the Association shall be managed by a Board of Directors Consisting of Nine elected members each with a designated responsibility defined as follows:**

- (h) Director of Bangladesh-American Center, who shall be responsible for managing all activities related to Bangladesh American Center project.**
- (i) Director of Public Affairs, who shall be responsible for managing all public relations affairs of the Association.**

**Article-VII Committee: The Board of Directors shall have the right to form any number of committees to help manage the operation of the organization including but not limited to the following:**
